

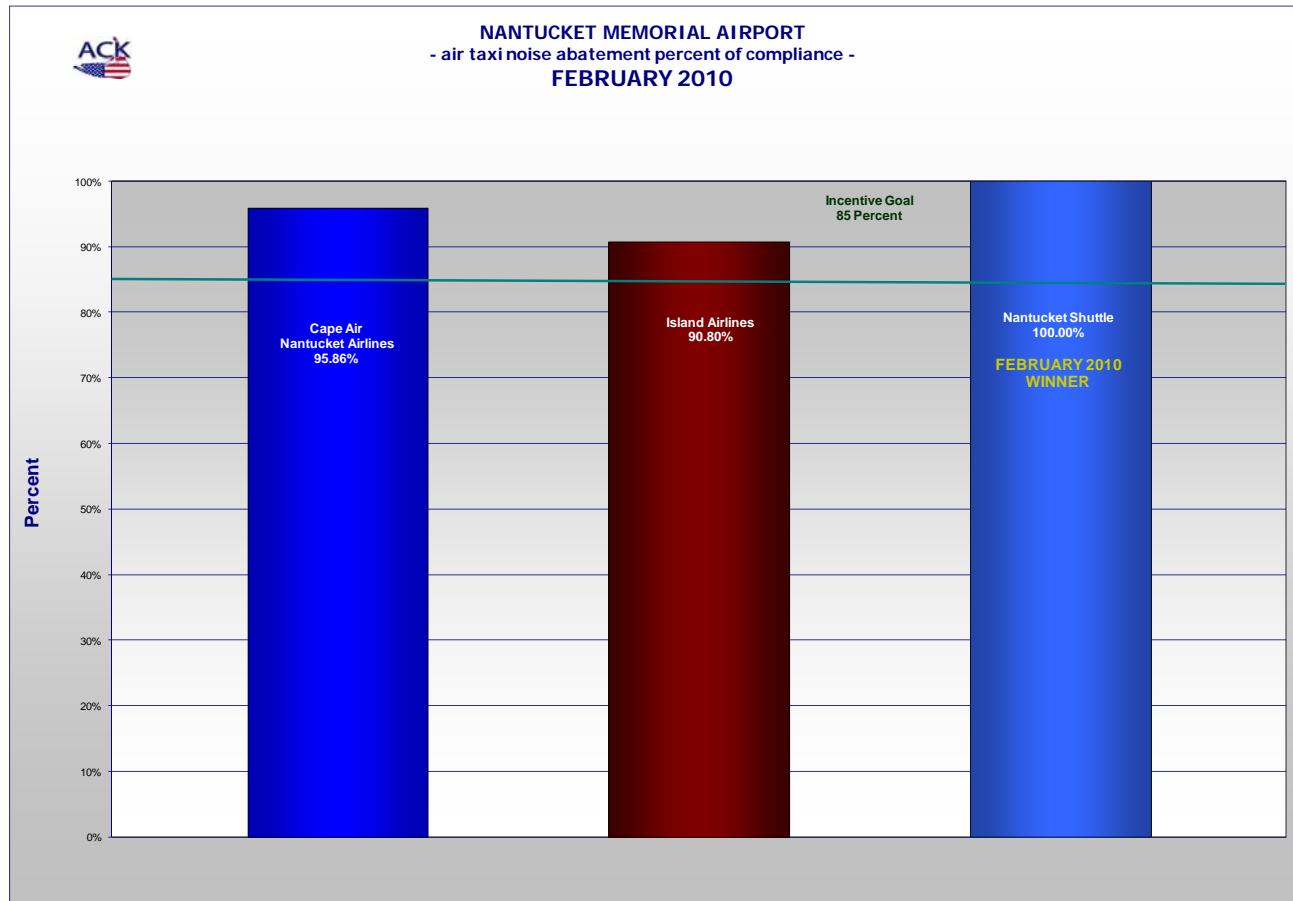

NANTUCKET SHUTTLE AIRLINES NAMED RECIPIENT OF THE NOISE ABATEMENT INCENTIVE AWARD FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 2010.

NANTUCKET, MA (March 1, 2010) – Nantucket Shuttle Airlines has been named the recipient of the air taxi noise abatement incentive award for the month of February. Nantucket Shuttle Airlines outperformed the field of air taxi airlines by posting a perfect 100% compliance record for the month. Cape Air/Nantucket Airlines finished second at 95.86% and Island Airlines was third at 90.80%. February was the sixth month in a row that all three local airlines achieved results above the Incentive Goal of 85.0% compliance and the fifth month in a row that Nantucket Shuttle Airlines has captured the monthly award.

The following chart shows the results for the month of February, 2010.



The Nantucket Memorial Airport Commission believes that part of its mission is to help maintain the tranquil atmosphere on the island and, to that end, introduced voluntary routes to mitigate aircraft noise several years ago. The air taxi companies that provide service to and from Nantucket have noted that compliance with these voluntary noise abatement routes takes extra time and uses extra fuel. In order to provide some incentives to these companies to follow noise abatement routes whenever possible, the Commission approved changes to the incentive plan in 2009. If a company achieves an 85% overall compliance rate, 15% of the landing fees for that company for the month will not be charged. In addition to a reduction in landing fees charged, the air taxi airline with the highest compliance percentage over 85% will receive \$500.00 in Nantucket Memorial Airport coupons for airline personnel to use at Crosswinds Restaurant or the Gift Shop.

All local airlines will receive a 15% discount on their February landing fees and Nantucket Shuttle Airlines will receive \$500 in Nantucket Memorial Airport coupons. Congratulations for a job well done!
